

# Frequently Asked Questions Alpha Kappa Lambda National Conclave & Officers' Institute

# **Undergraduate Members**

#### Who Needs to Register?

- Each chapter must send two official delegates.
  - o The delegates are typically the President and Vice-President.
  - o Delegates will register via MyAKL.org using the "Undergraduate Delegate" option.
  - o The chapter will be billed for both delegates after the event.
- Each chapter should also send their Treasurer and Recruitment Chair.
  - Training is offered during the Officers' Institute for both roles as well as additional training for the President and Vice-President.
    - Registration options include Full Registration Package, Individual Meals, or No Meals.

### Who is Responsible for Hotel Costs?

- One room, per chapter, for Friday & Saturday night, is covered by the Fraternity.
  - o Each room fits up to four chapter members.
- Chapters that require a Thursday night reservation will be billed after the event.
- Chapters needing a second room should contact the National Fraternity National Headquarters.

# Who Covers Travel Expenses?

- Chapters are responsible for their own travel, consistent with past practices for National Conclave & Officers' Institute.
- Chapters may collaborate with alumni and volunteers to assist with costs such as sharing frequent flyer miles.

# Why Are Some Costs Covered and Not Others?

- The AKL Education Foundation annually fund the Clark-Thompson Presidents' Academy
   & Officers' Institute via a grant, which covers:
  - o Two nights lodging.
  - o Most event expenses for two undergraduate attendees per chapter.
- The AKL Education Foundation cannot fund National Conclave expenses; therefore, a
  registration fee is charged. Combining the two events allows for significantly lower costs
  to the chapter because certain aspects can be covered by the grant when separate events
  would not.

#### **Alumni Members**

#### Why Should Alumni Attend?

- Alpha Kappa Lambda is a lifelong brotherhood. Attending enhances connections, mentorship, and engagement.
- Alumni participation is essential for:
  - Fraternity governance
  - Supporting undergraduate leadership

#### Who Needs to Register?

- National Executive Council (NEC)members, alumni association delegates, and housing corporation delegates participating in legislation, must register for the full event.
- Alumni attending education sessions, meals, or social events may choose:
  - · Full Registration
  - · Saturday-Only package
  - · Individual Meals

## Who is Responsible for Hotel Costs?

• Alumni are responsible for arranging and paying for their own lodging. Housing corporations or alumni associations should reimburse their delegates for lodging costs.
